

Are You Interested in Quitting Smoking?

The Nicotine Dependence Clinic at the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (CAMH) invites individuals who wish to quit smoking to participate in a study of a proven treatment for smoking cessation.

All study participants will receive varenicline (Champix)

Trans-cranial Direct Current Stimulation (tDCS)

involves application of very low level electric stimulation (less than a flashlight) to the scalp.

The present study will assess whether **tDCS** can further improve the effectiveness of **varenicline treatment** for smokers who want to quit.



You may be eligible to participate if you are:

- ❖ Aged 19 - 55
- ❖ Intending to quit smoking
- ❖ Not taking any drugs or medications that could interact with the treatment
- ❖ Not pregnant, trying to conceive, or breastfeeding
- ❖ Able to attend 10 consecutive weekday (M-F) sessions (~1 hour each) and 5 booster sessions (~1 hour each)
- ❖ Able to attend three fMRI Brain Scan sessions (~1 hour each)
