

Do you experience OBSESSIONS and/or COMPULSIONS? Participants needed for brain imaging research study

Researchers at CAMH are conducting a PET (positron emission tomography) imaging research study to learn more about individuals with obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD).

You may be eligible if you:

- aged 18 - 50 years old
- experience frequent unwanted thoughts or urges that keep coming back (obsessions) that might cause you to perform repetitive behaviors (compulsions) **or** be diagnosed with OCD
- no current substance use disorders
- no blood clotting disorder or use of blood thinner medication
- no unstable medical condition
- no neurological illness (seizures, epilepsy) or head trauma
- no metal implants in body
- not pregnant / breastfeeding
- not claustrophobic
